

Kim Lewellen Junior Golf Camp at Wake Forest University

Dates: June 28-July 2, 2020 Ages: 8-18

Instruction and Supervision

The camp is led by head women's golf Coach Kim Lewellen. Four-time ACC Coach of the Year. In her first season she lead the Wake Forest women's golf to an ACC championship and NCAA runner-up. She came to Wake Forest after 11 seasons as the head coach at the University of Virginia. At Virginia, Lewellen led the Cavaliers to the 2015 and 2016 ACC Championships among nine overall team titles. In nine of her 11 seasons, Virginia advanced to the NCAA Championship, including back-to-back 4th place finishes in 2011 and 2012 and reaching the match play quarterfinals in 2016. Her Virginia teams featured 12 WGCA All-Americans, 18 All-ACC selections and 11 tournament medalists, including 2012 ACC Player of the Year Brittany Altomare and 2016 ACC Player of the Year Lauren Coughlin.

Associate Head Coach Ryan Potter brings an extensive background of 12 years in collegiate coaching both on the men's and women's side. He has been at Ole Miss, Ohio State, UNLV and most recently UNC-Charlotte. He has taught in many camps throughout his career.

Each camper will receive personal instruction on full swing, chipping, putting, and will be supervised at all times. Coach Lewellen and Coach Potter will be joined by other collegiate coaches. Campers will be grouped by age and skill level. This camp is open to all entrants, subject to following ages of 7 years old and under, a camper must be 8 years old or older to participate.

Special Camp Features

Camp handbook: Fitness, nutrition and training tips will be in each campers Camp Handbook.

Evening sessions: Overnight campers will have additional programs with Sports Psychology, Fitness, College admissions and Recruiting.

Rules/Etiquette/Course Management: Breakout sessions and on the course basic rules and course etiquette training.

Camp Tournament: In addition to daily play, the final day of camp will give campers the opportunity to apply what they have learned in a competitive event the final day of camp. Prizes will be awarded for each category the final day of camp.

Camp accommodations: Overnight campers will stay in the newly built, air conditioned dorms only a short distance from the Arnold Palmer Golf Complex. Meals will be provided by campus meal services.

Gifts and prizes: All campers will receive participation gifts and will compete for prizes throughout the week.

Enrollment and Cost

To ensure a quality camp experience enrollment will be limited. Please respond to reserve your space in the camp. A non-refundable deposit of \$250 along with your filled out application is needed to reserve your space (see registration below and payment through Paypal). Application and deposit due by June 14, 2020.

This year's camp will offer two different enrollment options:

Full overnight camper. Cost for this option is \$1350 for the full session. This includes all instruction, golf, all meals, night sessions and overnight accommodations at Wake Forest University's newly built dormitories. Minimum age for overnight campers is 11 years old. **Multi-registration discount** of \$500 when registering more than one child for overnight camp.

Day camper: Cost for this option is \$850. The Day Camper will participate in all camp activities during the day and lunch will be provided daily. Minimum age for day campers is 8 years old. **Multi-registration discount** of \$300 when registering more than one child as day camper.

Check in/check out

The remainder of the camp fee is due June 14th via Paypal. (You will be emailed an invoice a few day prior to June 14th.) The medical form and waiver will be emailed to you one week before the camp with a full camp itinerary, you will turn in the medical form and signed wavier at camp day registration. If you have any dietary concerns and request they will need to be emailed to kimlewellengolf@gmail.com by June 14th.

Overnight campers will check in to the dorms on Sunday June 28th between 2:00-3:00pm. A separate check for \$75 will be required as a room key deposit (please bring a time of checkin). All other campers will arrive at the golf complex by 4:00pm.

Travel

Campers flying to camp will need to make flights into Greensboro Piedmont Triad International Airport. Airline departures for Thursday July 2nd should be after 4:30pm. You may make ground transportation arrangements with Barefoot Transportation at 336-723-2298.
